

Rust in grain is reported from Qualicum, Nanaimo, Steveston, and no doubt common in other sections, especially where grain is sown late, and consequently late in ripening.

**Rust.** The cultivation of vigorous, early ripening varieties of grain is recommended as the best method of dealing with rust, combined with proper drainage of the soil, and rotation of crops—matters too often neglected by farmers.

Mildew on peas is reported from Nicola, and common on late crops of Mildew on Peas, garden peas in the lower country. The method advised for rust in grain will apply here.
