

TAXABLE PROPERTY, &c.

There shall be raised, levied and collected from the owners of dogs within the district, the sum of five shillings for each and every dog, for each and every year, excepting, nevertheless, such as are exempted by the act of the Legislature, and said tax shall commence with the year 1846. By-Law, Feb. 1846.

All dogs in the district shall be furnished with a collar, which shall be placed and worn on the necks of said dogs, said collars to bear the names of the owners of such dogs, and that, after the first day of May, 1846, the owner of any dog not provided as aforesaid, and running at large, shall forfeit and pay for every such dog, for every day so unprovided and running at large, the sum of five shillings, to be recovered, on information, before one justice of the peace.
