GERMANY DISPUTES FRENCH FIGURES

Declares Its Reparations
Payments are Vastly Larger
Than Credited in Paris
—Consul Issues Statement

The figures showing the smallness of German reparation payments, which were made public in Paris by the Reparation Commission, were disputed by the German Government through its consul in London, Mr. Consul Lang, who issued a statement recently prepared in Berlin which indicates that the German reparation payments in money to date aggregate approximately three-fourths of a billion gold marks more than the figures given in French reports. Total payments are put at 8,942,970,000 gold marks.

The figures of the Reparation Commission indicate that Germany up to the present has paid on money 1,425,000,000 gold marks, while Berlin maintains that "total payments in money" amount to 2,193,470,000, a difference of 768,470,000 gold marks.

The office of the German Consul, 11 Broadway, issued the following statement:

In view of the figures given out in Paris as to total payments made by Germany on reparations, it may be of interest to compare with them the following figures recently prepared in Berlin:

CITY BUILT SEWER WITHOUT OUTLET

Although Useless, Boring
Proprietors were Taxed
to Tune of \$25,000—
Roll Held to be Illegal in
Montreal Court.

(Montreal Gazette.)
On the ground that the sewers laid on Monk boulevard and Beaulieu street, in St. Gabriel ward (formerly the town of Ennals), have not been of any service to the property owners, "and may not be of service for years to come," the Superior Court yesterday afternoon gave judgment maintaining the action of the Compagnie des Terrains de la Banlieue de Montreal, and other interested proprietors, and quashed the civil roll which had assessed the plaintiffs for the work of sewer construction at a sum of \$25,000.

Plaintiffs based their attack on the legality of the assessment roll on four grounds. First, because the charge was too high. The work was done in 1915-16 by day labor, and the plaintiffs declared that the cost had been allowed to go beyond what could be properly charged against the adjacent property owners.

Secondly, because the sewers at the present time are of no practical use, inasmuch as there is no discharge basin yet built.

Thirdly, that the city had failed to give the necessary notices of the homologation of the assessment roll.

Fourthly, that, according to a by-law passed by the municipality of Ville Ennals, before annexation to the city, these sewers were not to cost the taxpayers more than \$125 a foot, which would considerably reduce the cost as now charged.

The city's defence was a general denial of the plaintiffs' allegations.

Mr. Justice de Lorimier, in his judgment, said: "The evidence goes to show that the two sewers in question are blocked at their extremities, and have never been joined to a discharge sewer. Consequently, they cannot serve the purpose for which they are intended. According to the testimony of Mr. McLeod, civil engineer, and a superintendent of sewer construction for the city, the discharge basin for these sewers has not been constructed, and he could not state with any certainty just when it would be completed. It might be at the end of 1923, in five years' time, or even later, according to the civic authorities might decide."

The same witness admitted that it would be useless to connect these two new sewers with the collecting sewer, which is quite logical in the circumstances. It proved that it was unnecessary and of no advantage to construct the Monk boulevard and Beaulieu street sewers before providing a discharge sewer into which they might discharge.

"Seeing, therefore, that these two sewers have been or are being constructed, and that they were built until today, and that they can be of no service to the property they are intended to drain for a long time to come, it would be unjust to make the proprietors pay the cost."

The court in consequence—without entering into any discussion of the other grounds of attack made by plaintiffs—maintains the latter's action and quashes and annuls the roll on which plaintiffs were assessed for the cost of the sewers as being unjust, abusive, oppressive, ultra vires and illegal.

Costs were taxed against the city.

RECKLESS MOTORIST KILLED

War Hero Was Fined for Fast Driving an Hour Before.

Hammon, N. J., Oct. 10.—Carl Wayne Walton, twenty-seven years old, a war veteran and former prohibition commissioner in charge of Gloucester

County, N. J., was killed when he drove his car into a telegraph pole on the White Horse Pike near Dervonville, N. J., one hour after he had been fined \$10 and warned for reckless driving.

Walton at the time of the fatal accident were four women and two men. Three were seriously injured.
