

Chase In Broadway After \$4,700 Holdup In Room Over Bank

Trust Company Customer Is Followed Upstairs and Beat-en by Two Thieves.

New York, June 16.—The biggest payroll hold-up ever perpetrated in Jersey City took place when an unarmed bank messenger was relieved of more than \$12,000 at the point of a gun, in the "Gammontown" district of tenements and factories, near the North River shore.

The victim was Lake McDaniet, twenty-eight years old, colored messenger of the Hudson County National and Union Trust Company, at Montgomery and Washington streets. At the bank it was asserted the loss was fully covered by insurance.

Acting Police Chief Theodore Wolfe and Inspector Timothy J. Murphy, who had direct charge of ten squads of detectives in search of the robbers, entered protests because the bank had rejected special police protection.
