Francis Daillebont, aged 46 years, duly sworn, declares and says:-

I know the parties in this case. I know the land in dispute. I worked on the land in dispute with the late Pierre Montour 22 years ago breaking up the land. The first time I went there, I went to cut underbrush. I worked on this land for the late Montour every spring for five consecutive years, and at other times in the autumn. I was there at other times to lend him a hand, but I was not engaged. I once saw the late Osius Meloche cutting wood on this land, and Pierre Montour sent him there; and Meloche cut on his land below the hill; he cut five perches. Montour did not buy this land: he took possession of it in order to work it in accordance with the custom at the time.
