François Saillebont, aged 46 years, duly sworn, declares and says:-I know the parties in this case. Nenow the land in dispute. I worked on the land in dispute with the late lievre Montour 22 years ago breaking up the land. The great time Iwent there, I went to cut underbrush. Inviked on this land for the late Grontour every spring for five consenting years, and at other times in the artum. Iwas there at ather times to lend him a hand, but I was not engaged. Souse sam the late Osias beloche cutting wood on this land, and there Scontour sent him there; and kuloche cut on his land below the hill; be cut five perches. Guoutour did not buy this land: he took possession get in order to work it in accordance with the custom at the time. I do not know whether the man called the oldlyrey Horse had my land there: Sneder heard him say so . Theland
