RAILWAY TRAFFIC BETWEEN BULGARIA AND TURKEY STOPPED

London, July 19.—"A ministerial order was issued today," says the Times Sofia, Bulgaria, correspondent, under date of last Thursday, "definitely suspending railway communication with Turkey. The step appears to have been taken in consequence of continued Turkish interference with traffic, and may probably be regarded as marking the collapse of the negotiations for the cessation to Bulgaria of the Dedeaghatoh railway."
