of the servants employed in the mess, will prefer his complaint to the President of the mess committee.

15 The discussion of any regimental subjects whatever at the mess is strictly forbidden.

16. No spirits will be placed on the table during dinner.

17. The practice of officers taking wine with one another is obsolete at mess. Every one will order his own wine, but no champagne will be served to one individual without the sanction of the mess President.

18. Two officers may share one bottle of wine but the whole bottle will be charged to the one ordering it.

19. No member of the mess (except members of the committee) is to enter the mess room before dianer is announced.

20. No article of any description belonging to the mess is on any account to be taken out of the mess, and no periodicals are to be taken out until relieved by a later copy or number, and no book or news paper is ever to be taken from the ante room without informing the mess sergeant, or one of the waiters.
