WEBB, William Hoste, Q. C. [*Richmond and Wolfe.*] C.

Eldest s. of the late Commander Edward Webb, R. N., who migrated to Canada in 1836. Ed. at the Royal Naval School, London, England. Called to the Bar L. C. Created Q. C., 1867. Is President of the Agricultural Society of the county of Richmond; and a Trustee of St. Francis College, Richmond, P. Q. Was the first Warden elected for that County. Has been Mayor of the Municipality. Sat for Richmond and Wolfe in Leg. Assembly, Can., from 1858 until g. e. 1861, when he was defeated; and again from g. e. 1863 until the Union. Was an unsuccessful candidate for L. C. division of Wellington in 1856. Pop. 15,432.—*Melbourne, P. Q.*
