any assurance whatsoever, on any buildings whatsoever situated in the towns and villages.

Proportion to IV. In the event of any loss by fire, every person assured shall only contributed contribute to the amount of the said loss, in proportion to the amount for which he shall be assured in the said Association.

Office of Association, where held.

V. Each such Parish Mutual Assurance Association shall have an Office, in a central situation in its own locality; Provided always, that so soon as the said Association shall have selected a place in the said locality for holding their office, they shall give public notice thereof, by advertising the same four times in the English and French 10 languages in the Canada Gazette, or in some other official Gazette or Newspaper, and should the said Association after such notice remove their Office to another place, they shall also give notice thereof in the same manner; and the service of any legal or other document at the Office of the Association to which such document shall relate shall be 15 held to be valid and effectual to all intents and purposes whatsoever.

Public Act. VI. This Act shall be a public Act.
