servant of the said Corporation employed in the transmission or delivery of intelligence or messages, shall, before he enters on the duties of his office, make oath before a judge or justice of the Peace that he will not wilfully divulge the contents of any message transmitted by the said Corporation, or left with any of its operators, agents, 5 or servants for transmission or delivery; and every person violating the said oath shall be adjudged guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by case of viola- imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or by a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
