BILL.

An Act to amend the Act Incorporating the Trustees of the Toronto Hospital.

WHEREAS in and by An Act passed by the Parliament Preamble. of this Province, in the Session thereof held in the tenth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's reign, intituled "An "Act to incorporate the Trustees of the Toronto Hospital," 5 it is amongst other things in effect enacted that the two Senior Professors of any School of Medicine to be thereafter established in the City of Toronto, and in default of or until the establishment of such School, any such medical men resident in the said City as should be nominated and appointed as 10 vacancies should occur by the Common Council of the said City in Common Council assembled at any meeting of such Common Council, should be members of the Corporation created by the said Act, and whereas it is desirable to repeal the aforesaid provision of the said Act; Be it enacted, &c. 15 that from and after the passing of this Act no Professor of Who shall be any School of Medicine established or to be established in Trustes of the Hospital in futhe said City of Toranto shall be ex officio a member of the ture said Corporation of the Trustees of the Toronto Hospital, nor shall any medical men resident in the said City be nomi-20 nated or appointed as such Trustees by the Common Council of the said City as vacancies shall in future occur; but such vacancies shall in future be filled up by the Governor in Council, who shall from henceforth have power to appoint from time to time five persons resident in the said City, instead of 25 three persons as provided for by the said Act, to be members of the said Corporation; and the said Corporation shall at all times consist of the officers and persons now lawfully composing the same under the provisions of the said Act or hereafter to compose the same under the provisions of the said Act and

30 of this Act, the latter being hereby declared to be the lawful

successors of the former.
