BILL.

An Act to amend the "Act incorporating the Mem-"bers of the Medical Profession in Lower Ca-"nada, and to regulate the Study and Practice "of Physic and Surgery therein," and to afford relief to certain persons who were in Practice as Physicians and Surgeons in this Province at the time when the said Act became Law.

HEREAS it is expedient to amend an Act passed Preamble. in the Session held in the tenth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to incorporate 10 and 11 v. " the Members of the Medical Profession in Lower Canada; c. 26. 5 " and to regulate the Study and Practice of Physic and "Surgery therein," to afford relief to certain persons who were in practice as Physicians and Surgeons in this Province at the time when the said Act became Law: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

10 That any person who was practising as a Physician and Certain per-Surgeon and Accoucheur in that portion of this Province sons in pracheretofore Lower Canada, before and on the twenty-eighth Canada, on day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight 28th July, 1847, shall be hundred and forty-seven, when the said cited Act became entitled to a 15 Law, who had, at any time previous to the last mentioned license without examination. date, obtained a Medical Degree or Diploma in any University, College or Institution in the United States of America, shall be intitled to receive a license to practice Physic, Surgery and Midwifery in this Province without 20 being subjected to any examination whatsoever.

And be it enacted, That any person who was prac- Certain other tising as a Physician and Surgeon in that portion of this persons in Province heretofore Lower Canada, on the twenty-eighth Lower Canada day of July, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight on the said day, may obsuice in this Province for ten years provinced. such in this Province for ten years previous thereto, shall on ertain conditions withbe entitled to receive a license to practice Physic, Sur-out examinagery and Midwifery in Lower Canada; Provided that tion. such person shall obtain a certificate of qualification in 30 the form of the Schedule (A,) hereunto annexed, signed by at least three licensed Physicians resident within the District where such person practised as aforesaid, without being subject to any examination or any other formality, any law to the contrary hereof notwithstanding.
