rity aforesaid, that the Clerks of the Peace shall deliver to the Sheriffs of their respective Districts, a duplicate of the lists so certified and returned on or before the first day of August next following, and shall enter the said lists fairly into a Book, which shall be by them kept among the Records of the Court of General Quarter Sessions.

Copies of Orders &c. to be delivered to Sheriffs.

XI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the Clerks of the Peace shall also deliver to the Sheriffs of the respective Districts, within ten days from their respective dates, certified copies of all Orders made under the authority of this Act for inserting into any such lists, or striking out therefrom, the name or names of any person or persons unduly omitted or inserted therein.

Sheriffs to cause the names on the lists to be alphabetically entered in a book &c.

XII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that every Sheriff shall cause all the names contained in the duplicates of the said lists which shall be transmitted to him by the Clerks of the Peace in virtue of this Act, to be faithfully and alphabetically entered with their additions and places of abode, in some Book or Books to be kept by him for that purpose; and shall also insert in such Book or strike out therefrom all such names as shall be ordered to be inserted into or struck out of any of the said lists, by any Order made under the authority of this Act, and of which a certified copy shall have been transmitted to such Sheriff by the Clerks of the Peace in virtue of this Act.

No person but such as is named in the lists shall be summoned to serve as Juror.

XIII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that no Sheriff or person to whom the return of Juries shall belong, shall summon and return any person to be or serve on any Jury, in any Court of King's Bench having Criminal Jurisdiction, or in any Court of Oyer and Terminer or general Gaol delivery or Session of the Peace that shall not be named in the said list.

Persons named as Jurors may be examined on oath as to their qualifications.

XIV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that every person who shall be Summoned to serve as a Juror in any of the Courts aforesaid, may be examined upon oath as to his being qualified to serve as such Juror in any of the said Courts under the requirements of this Act.

XV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that if any Sheriff or other Officer to whom the return of Juries shall be-
