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“ And we do further enjoin you not to propose any act whereby our Prerogative might be diminished or in any respect infringed, without our special permission previously obtained, and if any Bill having such an effect shall be presented to you for your assent, you shall declare that you reserve it for the signification of our pleasure.”

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“ And we do further direct that you do not propose or assent to any Act whatever, whereby Bills of Credit or other negotiable Securities of whatever nature, may be issued, in lieu of money on the credit of the said Province, or whereby any Government Paper Correny may be established therein, or whereby any such Bills or any other paper currency, or any coin, save only the legal coin of the Realm, may be made or declared
