And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That so much of an Act, made in the Seventeenth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, An Act for repealing the Eleventh Rule in the Book of Rates, so far as the same relates to the making any Allowance upon the Importation of damaged Currants and Raisins, and for making the Importer of such Goods an Abatement in the Duties in lieu thereof; and for explaining the said Rule with respect to such Allowance for Damage on other Goods; and to permit the Exportation of Tobacco-pipe Clay from this Kingdom to the *British* Sugar Colonies or Plantations in the *West Indies*, for a limited Time; as permits the Exportation of Tobacco-pipe Clay from this Kingdom to the *British* Sugar Colonies or Plantations in the *West Indies*, which was to continue in force until the Twenty-fourth Day of June, One thousand seven hundred and seventy-nine, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament; shall be, and the same is hereby further continued from the Expiration thereof, until the Twenty-fourth Day of June, One thousand seven hundred and eighty-three, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament.
