I wish to remind you that it have been patiently waiting the Departments Pleasure to issue that fifty years lease in favour of the Canadian Northern Railway for the Purpose of Building a Pump House and laying pipe across my Farm to the Tank near the Station And also a right of way to Pass too and from said Pump House the Bay Shore.

And I may inform you that the Mohawk Council Confirmed the of the lease nearly two years there has nothing been done matter it was to be paid at the \$5<sup>00</sup> a year But was to advance as soon as they got the lease the first twenty five years Rent Then again advance the other Half at the expense of the first twenty five years

The C N R also have taken more of my land near the Station the value amounting to \$60<sup>00</sup> Sixty Dollars which sum I have not yet received

Our Indian Agent Mr [redacted] informed me the above sum is in the hands of the Department I would like to have it for in need of it.

The agreement it made with Co. was to have every paid twenty days
