19 TUESDAY. [102-905]

very fine day Brinkman at Beardys Peter and Joseph were drawing wood and rails I am very sick with a head ache James was dividing the stock the mail got in

Game 4 meals

20 WEDNESDAY. [103-906]

Started Peter across the river to one arrow with 20 loads of flour and 300 loaves he got over the ice all right Brinkman came down from Beardys to report progress and get some grub James & I were drawing wood and much the cattle old Mike started for home by the river my face is no better

Game 2 meals

21 THURSDAY. [104-907]

fine day I saw one hare I. e. at Stoharts I gave Peter and his garden and Brinkman is at Beardys Peter is at one arrow the boys were cleaning wheat I had a forenoon with some Indians the day that they will not work if don't get the

Game 1 meal

22 GOOD FRIDAY. [105-908]

very fine day the snow is melting rather fast I went to the Beardys River Brinkman is doing very well they are cutting and killing fish I killed 2 Omeasas has two loads all pretty well out Peter is sick over all tomorrow I cannot get across the river the ice is broken the boys were cleaning grain & doing the cattle I am a little better

23 SATURDAY. [106-909]

fine day the snow disappeared very fast Brinkman is at Beardys Peter is at one arrow the boys were cleaning wheat & doing the chores my face is some better

Game 1 meal

24 EASTER SUNDAY. [107-910]

very fine day snow going fast Peter could not get across the river he will have to the night will

18 MONDAY. [108-911]

very fine day snow going fast I went to Carlton to see the agent he was at River Albert I got 25 lbs. flour & 2 cans B. Powder I sent Brinkman with flour & more up to Beardys all the Indians refused to work I took the flour & B. Powder away James & Joseph were working around the farm until noon the were cleaning wheat the rest of the day

Game 1 meal

19 TUESDAY. [109-912]

very fine day snow disappearing fast had a forenoon with some of Beardys men & Omeasas Alex Gee and James were cleaning wheat & oats Brinkman was splitting in doing the work I went up to the station but to forget some tea got 2 lbs I did not see the agent

Game 4 meals

20 WEDNESDAY. [110-913]

very soft and foggy Brinkman and Alex Gee were cleaning wheat 2 of Beardys composites came and we had a forenoon they agreed to go to work the same as before Joseph was working around and looking after the stock James is very sick no work from Peter the ice is breaking the mail is coming this Sunday

Game 7 meals

21 THURSDAY. [111-914]

very fine day the snow is almost gone I went to visit Omeasas had a big forenoon with him & Omeasas the Brinkman went up to Beardys he gave them 1 bag flour & 25 lbs. bacon they are working Alex Gee and Omeasas were cleaning wheat I was looking after the cattle I saw the I. e. as Jack Lake he man is here

22 FRIDAY. [112-915]

fine day I saw the agent he went to River Albert his and 3 horses was here over night Brinkman is at Beardys the are working Alex Gee and Omeasas were cleaning barley James is some better Joseph was cleaning around Peter came home from one arrow

Game 5 meals

23 SATURDAY. [113-916]

St. George's Day. very fine day Beardys sowed 6 bushel wheat Brinkman took 12 up to Beardys Peter took a plough down to river for one arrow I was trying to get a man to take the cattle to Battleford old muttough would not go after all Alex Gee and Omeasas were cleaning barley I had a big forenoon with Beardys & an arrow

24 LOW-SUNDAY. 1 after Easter. [114-917]

beautiful day I hired the American Chief for 12 days to take the cattle to Battleford
