and the instruction given the Indian mi farming should be changed with the least possible delay, so for as the Indian under Fraties 4 am 6 are evucerned; and as respects Those interested in heavy 7, a similar change should be made as soon as it is practicable to do so. The Supt General also authorizes all the Instructions at present employed being notified that, after a certain date, their Services will not be required. The Supst General Justin directs that competent and releable onen should be engaged at a monthly salary; and should find themselves, - one of whom should reside upon each Reserve to nintricel the Indians by superintenday and
