

Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 3rd Instant, enclosing an agreement for lease between Daniel McDougall, Locatee of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 1, Con. 2, Tuscarora and Captain W.C. Vanloon and Captain Benjamin A. Griffith, for lease of said land for 3 years to be used for rifle practice at an annual rental of \$20.00, I beg to say that as the property in question comprises an area of 100 acres, the rental offered appears entirely inadequate.

If it is intended that only a portion of the half lot should be leased, a proper description thereof should be given, and you should report fully as to whether the use to be made of the land so leased, would in any way interfere with use and occupation of the remaining portion of the half lot.
