I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th, instant, enclosing applications and certificates of health for admission of Solomon and Thomas Miller to the Cequaloctsa Industrial school.

In reply, I beg to say that the admission of these two children is approved. With regard to Thomas Miller it is noted that the doctor states, -"One testis enlarged but not particularly unhealthy at present". The Department trusts that this boy will receive special attention.

I would also refer you to official letter of the 7th, inst. in which you were requested to state why Magnus Green signed the application for the admission of Edgar Green, when both the parents of this boy are living. You will be good enough to furnish this information as soon as possible.
