Ottawa, 11th February, 1919.

Sirs-

The Department is desirous of having your firm supply drugs required for use at the Roman Catholic Mission, Fort Albany and St. Paul's Mission, Fort Albany; and also the Roman Catholic Mission at Attawapiscat, all of which places are on James Bay. The drugs should be carefully packed and sent before the 1st of March to the Revillon Freres Trading Company, 134 McGill St., Montreal, which firm will take charge of the consignment and make delivery at the Missions.

The drugs should be packed in strong cases & the weight of each case should be within 125 lbs.

The drugs for the Roman Catholic Mission at Fort Albany should be addressed to Rev. L. Carriere, Albany, James Bay. The drugs for St. Paul's Mission should be addressed to Rev. J.T. Griffin, Missionary in charge, St. Paul's Mission, Albany Port and those for Attawapiscat should be addressed to Rev. S.P. Boisseau, Roman Catholic Mission, Attawapiscat Post. You will observe that in each case the address is on the list of drugs. The lists of the drugs required are enclosed herewith.

The accounts for the drugs should be forwarded to the Department in duplicate, but you should send with each consignment a copy of account, (in order that the articles may be checked ~~by the Department~~ when received,) which account the Department require to have certified by the recipient of the drugs.

You should take from Messrs. Revillon Freres a receipt for the number of packages which you hand over to them, which receipt you should attach to your account before you forward it to the Department.
