We the Saanich Band of Indians humbly pray that we want the so called treaty deleted on the following

1st. That the said treaty was made in the dark. We fully deny any knowledge of same. As we are fully aware what Sir James Douglas gave to our old peoples, was not for no land transaction whatever.

2nd. We want to be recognized by the Authority simlaral as other Indian tribes in the Province of British Columbia.

3rd. We do not mean to say, that we want the land back. No! - as it is settled by the settlers.

4th. We want the Authority to be lenient to us - and favor us compensation as saw fit.

We hereby subscribe our names.
