



THE HOLDEN BUILDING



IN THE HEART OF THE CITY

The Holden Building, a ten-story structure of the latest type of reinforced steel, stone, brick and concrete construction, is located on the South side of Hastings Street, a few steps from the corner of Carrall Street.

In view of the rapid upbuilding of Grandview, Mount Pleasant, Burraby, South Vancouver and Hastings Townsite, and the development of Main Street as a commercial thoroughfare, it is no exaggeration to say that the Holden Building is in the very heart of Greater Vancouver. It is only a stone's throw from the new station and terminus for the Westminster car line, now being built by the B. C. Electric Railway Co., and within easy walking distance of the North Vancouver ferry, the waterfront, the City Hall, Carnegie Library, etc. This convenience of location is only one of many strong points that commend it to exacting tenants.
