BIG RECORD IN NEW ZEALAND

The three-year-old Holstein heifer, Gladys 2nd, of the herd of Mr. G. Aitchison, of Kaitangata, which distinguished herself by having produced the largest quantity of milk in 100 days of any class, has now completed her milking record. Her record for 104 days' milking is 15,708.95 lbs. of milk, testing 1.88 per cent, and giving 614 lbs. of butter, 51.83 lbs. of butter-fat.

The heifer could not be milked for the full period of 365 days which she was entitled to under the conditions governing this contest. She will be practically five months earlier than any other heifer in this contest.

A RESULT OF BREEDING—Believing that the Province of Quebec must depend on the building up of its dairy herds, the use of foreign bulls on grades has not even been the introduction of registered cows.
