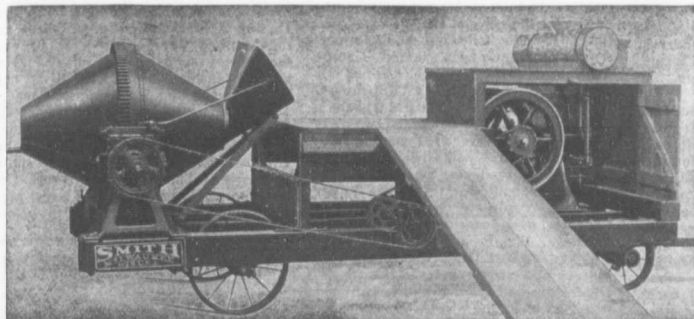

St. Clarens church have purchased a lot at corner of Dufferin and Dundas street on which a new church will be built in the near future. The Euclid ave. and Centennial congregations will also build new churches, and Westmoreland ave. church is to be enlarged.

HAMILTON, ONT. — John Smart has secured permits to build two brick houses, corner Markland and Queen streets, cost \$3,000.—J. J. Scott, K. C., states that the Eastern Building Co. intends building 100 more houses in the east end of the city.

CHATHAM, ONT.—J. L. Wilson & Son, architects, desire tenders by June 4 for erection of residence for A. C. Trudell; hot water or steam heating.—Tenders will be invited immediately for new armouries to be built in this city. The plans prepared show a drill hall 180x60 feet, in addition to armouries, library, lecture hall, etc.

ST. CATHARINES, ONT. — Plans prepared by W. B. Allan, architect, for new Y.M.C.A. building have been accepted.—J. McClelland, City Clerk, will receive tenders up to 3rd inst. for construction of about 40,000 square yards of macadam roadway.—St. Paul street Methodist church congregation contemplate making extensive alterations and improvements to the building.

ST. JOHNS, QUE. — The Singer Sewing Machine Co. have completed plans for their new factory. Twenty distinct buildings will be erected. The machine shop and woodworking shop will each be 78x60 feet, and four stories high. The company will likely install their own power plant and will build an electric road connecting with the main line.

OTTAWA, ONT.—The Department of Railways and Canals has extended the time for receiving tenders for power and telephone submarine cables for the Welland canal to June 2nd.—The City Engineer wants tenders by 15th inst. for permanent pavement on Albert street.—Engineers are making surveys of the Stewart property, which is to be utilized for the new geological survey and national museum building.

MONTREAL, QUE.—The time for receiving tenders for supply of two fire engines for the city has been extended to July 7th.—Tenders have been invited for erection of a parish church in Maisonneuve, estimated to cost \$125,000.—The City Council will likely construct a sewer to the Back river, at a cost of \$88,000. — McArthur & Co. have
