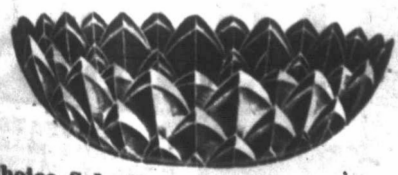

One of the most characteristic features of
modern culture is the attention given to the
facts, moods, and suggestions of "Nature."
The Cyclopædia of Nature Teachings is a
collection of remarkable passages from the
writings and utterances of the leading
authors, preachers and orators, which em-
body suggestive or curious information con-
cerning Nature. Each passage contains
some important or noteworthy fact or state-
ment which may serve to illustrate some
religious truth or moral principles, the ex-
tracts being gleaned from the widest and
most varied sources.

The volume forms a most valuable work
of reference, and by its orderly arrange-
ment puts its wealth of information and
suggestion at the disposition of the student
or teacher; but the varied character of the
selections, the freshness of the subjects
treated, and the literary grace of many of
the paragraphs, will also make the work
welcome to general readers.
