jesty's Treasury for the time being, in such manner and form as the Crown shall direct.

Ordained and Enacted by the authority aforesaid, and passed in Special Council, at the City of Quebec, the thirty first day of October, in the second year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady Victoria, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith, and so forth, in the year of Our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight.

CAP. VI.

An Ordinance to appropriate certain sums, annually, to enable Her Majesty to defray the expense of Pensions conferred on the Honorable Jonathan Sewell Esquire and the Honorable James Reid Esquire.

Preamble.

HEREAS it is just and expedient, in consideration of the advanced age, and the long and meritorious services of the Honorable Jonathan Sewell Esquire Chief Justice of the Province of Lower Canada, and of the Honorable James Reid Esquire, Chief Justice of the Court of King's Bench for the District of Montreal, that, on their retirement from the said offices respectively, a reasonable and fit provision should be made for them:—Be it therefore Ordained and Enacted by His Excellency the Governor of the said Province of Lower Canada, by and with the advice and consent of the Special Council for the affairs of the said Province, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Great Britain and Ireland, passed in the first year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, "An Act to make temporary provision for the Government of the Province of Lower Canada;"—And it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the authority
