

ORDERED, That Mr. *Justice De Bonne* and Mr. *Young* be of the said Committee.

An ingrossed Bill, to remove any doubts which may arise touching the validity of certain proceedings of the Court of King's Bench for Criminal Causes at *Quebec*, which said Court was not held in last September term from the absence of the Chief Justice of the Province; and which more effectually provides for holding the said Court in future at the periods fixed by Law, in the several Districts of *Quebec* and *Montreal*;—was read for the third time.

Mr. *Berthelot* moved, seconded by Mr. *Perinault*,

That the Bill do pass, and that the title be, “ An Act to remove any doubts which may arise touching the validity of certain proceedings of the Court of King's Bench for Criminal Causes at *Quebec*, which said Court was not held in last September term from the absence of the Chief Justice of the Province; and which more effectually provides for holding the said Court in future, at the periods fixed by Law, in the several Districts of *Quebec* and *Montreal*. ”

The House divided upon the question,

Nays	9

So it was accordingly resolved in the affirmative.

ORDERED, That Mr. *Berthelot* and Mr. *Perinault* do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.
