ORDERED, That Mr. Justice De Bonne and Mr. Young be of the faid Committee.

An ingroffed Bill, to remove any doubts which may arife touching the validity of certain proceedings of the Court of King's Bench for Criminal Caufes at Quebec, which faid Court was not held in laft September term from the abfence of the Chief Juffice of the Province; and which more effectually provides for holding the faid Court in future at the periods fixed by Law, in the feveral Diffricts of Quebec and Montreal;—was read for the third time.

Mr. Berthelot moved, feconded by Mr. Perinault,

That the Bill do pafs, and that the title be, "An Act to remove any doubts which may arife touching the validity of certain proceedings of the Court of King's Bench for Criminal Caufes at Quebec, which faid Court was not held in last September term from the absence of the Chief Justice of the Province; and which more effectually provides for holding the faid Court in future, at the periods fixed by Law, in the teveral Districts of Quebec and Montreal."

The House divided upon the question,

So it was accordingly refolved in the affirmative.

ORDERED, That Mr. Berthelot and Mr. Perinault do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and defire their concurrence.

And then, on motion of Mr. Perrault, feconded by Mr. Steel,
