Every Member is to fit in his due place when the Houfe is put into a Committee.

At any Committee of our own, any Member of our Houfe, though not of the Committee, is not excluded from coming in and speaking, but he must not vote. He shall also give place to all that are of the Committee, and shall sit behind them. The same order is also obferved at a conference with the Assembly:

If it be defired by any Member that the House be put into a Committee, it ought not to be refused.

No man is to enter at any Committee or conference, unlefs it be fuch as are commanded to attend; but fuch as are Members of the Houfe, upon pain of being punished feverely with example to others.

Refolved, that it is the right of every Member of this Houle, to bring in a Bill, and pray that it may be read.

For our meeting with any of the Lower Houfe, it is either upon occafion of Meffages which they fend up unto us, or upon conference. When they come up unto us, the manner is thus :- After we have notice given us by our Usher that they have sent unto us, they attend until we have put that bufinefs to fome end wherein we are; and then we (fitting) fend for them in, who ftand all at the loweft end of the room, and then the Speaker, with fuch as pleafe, rifeth, and goeth down to the middle of the Bar. Then, the chief of the Committee in the midil, and the reft about him, come up to the Bar with three obeylances, and deliver the Mellage to him : who, after he hath received it, retires himfelf to his former place. And the Houle being cleared and fettled, he reports it to the Members, who do help his memory, if any thing be millaken. And a'ter the Members have taken refolution, (if the bufinels require any answer) they are enher called for in, and approaching to the Bar with three obeylances, (as before) and the House fitting in order as before, the Speaker in his feat covered, noth give them their answer in the name of the Houle; or elle, if the refolution be not to speedy, we send for them in, and the Speaker informs them that they shall not need to flay for the anlwer, but we will lend it by fome express Mellenger of our own. None
