Ordered, That Mr. Butler, Mr. Burbidge, and Mr. White be the Committee of this House for that purpose.

And then adjourn'd till 11 o'Clock on Monday Morning.

Bill from the Council to prevent Trefpasses on Crown Lands. The Council sent down a Bill, intitled An Act to prevent Trespasses upon Crown Lands, to which they desire the concurrence of this House.

And the faid Bill was read.

Ordered, that it be read a fecond Time.

Mr. Archibald, having represented to the House, that he was prevented from attending the House in the Session of the General-Assembly last October, by Sickness, and that he did actually write a Letter to Mr. Speaker acquainting him thereof, (which Letter never came to Hand) and thereupon praying to be released from the Fine of Five Pounds, incurred for Non-attendance, and the House having taken the same into consideration. Resolved, that the said Fine be remitted.
