STEAMER REACHES MONTREAL JAFTER TERRIBLE VOYAGE

By Special Wire to the Courier.

Montreal, July 17.-With her bows crushed in and her stern down deep in the water to raise the damaged stem as far as possible from the sea, the Steamer Agenoria crawled into port early this morning to her berth at the upper end of Windam Point. Sunday morning she crashed into an iceberg while running through the ice covered straits of Belle Isle. Ninety bergs were sighted in the narrow passage, but the one that the ves-sel struck, although one hundred feet high, was not seen through the fog until it loomed up thirty feet away, dead ahead. Then it was too late and the Agenoria piled into the towering mass. Hatches were pulled off at once and when it was seen that the vessel was making water pretty fast, the seat was let into the stern tanks to raise he bow. The Agenoria is owned by Rickison and Sons of West Hartlepool, England.



SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH

WEST LAND REGULATIONS. THE sole head of a family, or any male

over 18 years old, any homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (but not Sub-Agency), on certain conditions.

Dutlev—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. **Price** \$3.00 per acre.

\$3.00 per acre.

Duties—Six months residence in each of three years after earning homestead patent; also 50 acres extra cultivation. Preemption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions.

A settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months is each of three years, cultivate 50 acres and erect a house worth \$300.

The area of cultivation is subject to reserve

The area of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough, scrubby or stony land. Live stock may be substituted few cultivation under certain conditions.
