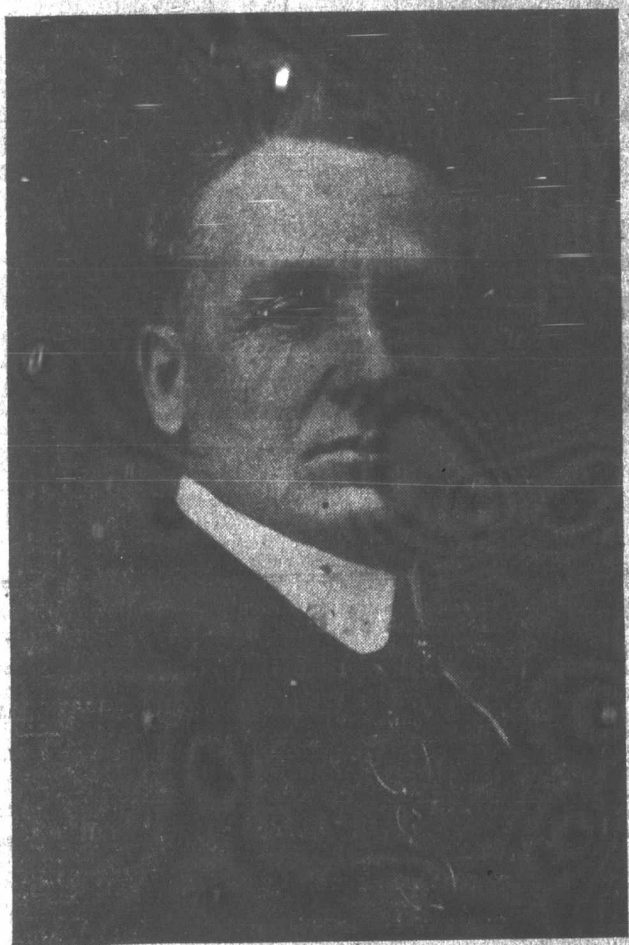


WHO WILL YOU VOTE FOR?
