## TEN THOUSAND LIVES LOST IN CHINA

Steamship Titan Brings Tale  
of Destruction by Tidal  
Wave.

BORE 26 FEET HIGH

Overwhelmed Thousands of  
Sampans and Small Boats &  
Wrecked River Steamers.

(Special to the Morning Graphic.)  
VICTORIA, Wednesday. — The  
steamship Titan brings news from  
China of one of the greatest disasters  
ever experienced there, causing a loss  
of close to 10,000 lives at Hankow.  
This was caused by a great tidal bore  
in the Yangtze River, 26 feet in  
height which overwhelmed thousands  
of sampans and small boats and  
wrecked some large river steamers.

## OUR MEN DROWNED FROM BOAT WHILE PLACING HEAVY ANCHOR

Recalls Frontier Tribes That Have  
Gone Into India.

(Special to the Morning Graphic.)  
SIMLA, British India, Monday. — Af-  
ter a long delay, the Ameer of Af-  
ghanistan has replied to the Indian  
Government's remonstrances against  
the invasion of British territory by the  
Afghans. The Ameer explains the  
difficulties of controlling the frontier  
tribes, and states that he has issued  
stringent orders recalling those who  
have crossed the border and instruct-  
ing the officials to prevent further in-  
cursions.

Advices from Peshawar yesterday  
stated that while Mohmand tribes-  
men were still giving the British au-  
thorities considerable trouble, the most  
of the Afghans had withdrawn. Major-  
General Sir James Willcocks, with  
two brigades of British and Indian  
forces, has been ordered to proceed  
with punitive measures and will take  
the field immediately against the  
Mohmands.

Boat Immediately Filled and Sank, Throwing Men Into  
Water—One Swam Ashore.

It is not often that Campbellton is  
stirred to its depths by a sad cala-  
mity, but today this town mourns  
the loss of four of its citizens; four  
men who at the dinner hour left  
wives and children never to return to  
their fireside alive, and the town  
mourns with them.

The First News.  
About three o'clock the word was  
passed that four men had been drown-  
ed off the Shives Lumber Company's  
mill wharf. Soon scores of citizens  
were hastening to the scene of the ac-  
cident.

The Particulars.

A number of men are at present  
engaged in making the necessary re-  
pairs to the Shives Lumber Co.'s  
shingle mill wharf. After dinner it  
was decided to replace the haul-up  
chain on its pulley. This pulley or  
sprocket wheel is under water and  
extends out into the river a few feet.

It was necessary to rig gear to haul  
up heavy chain out to place it in po-  
sition. For this purpose a heavy an-  
chor, which in this case was a heavy

bottom of the boat, tearing off about  
four feet of the plank, through  
which water poured, and before the  
men knew what had happened all  
were struggling in the water. They  
were heavily clothed and had on top  
boots. Savidant, a strong swimmer,  
was the only man to reach the shore.  
He was in a dazed condition and  
hardly knew what had happened or  
what had become of the others.

The stern of the boat, weighed down  
by the anchor, sank to the bottom,  
but as the water is not very deep,  
the bow floated well out of the water.  
The tide was falling and a very swift  
current was running which carried the  
men away from the boat, and as they  
were weighed down by boots and  
clothing, they had a poor chance.

Immediately boats put out and  
grapples were procured, but it was  
not until six o'clock that a body  
that of Jos. Roussi, was found. The  
search was continued until dark and  
will be continued today.

All the men are married, with fam-  
ilies ranging from three to five, and  
these unfortunate people have the sym-  
pathy of the community.

## RESTIGOUCHE AND WESTERN RAILWAY BONDS WERE DULY CANCELLED SAYS MR. MCKEOWN

Really Important Part of Transaction Was on Record in  
Counties of Victoria and Madawaska--Hazen Departing  
From Platform Severely Criticised.

(Special to the Morning Graphic.)  
FREDERICTON, Wednesday. — The  
Accounts Committee had another ses-  
sion this morning and spent the great-  
er part of the time discussing the Ag-  
ricultural department payments which  
were all finally passed as satisfac-  
tory.

Ex-Premier Robinson and ex-Attor-  
ney General McKeown appeared before  
the committee and explained the  
guarantee of the bonds of the Inter-  
national Railway.

Mr. Robinson stated that the com-  
pany had applied to the government  
for a guarantee of bonds to the ex-  
tent of \$250,000. An engineer had been  
sent to verify the statement made by  
the company and he had reported that  
work to the value of over a million  
dollars has been completed. Forty  
miles of railway were completed from  
Campbellton and there has been con-  
siderable progress made on the St.  
John end of the line. There were other  
large expenditures by the company  
which justified the government which  
had authority to take these, as well  
as release into consideration in guar-  
anteeing bonds to the extent of \$400,-  
000, which the executive council re-

commended. These bonds he had  
signed after being assured by Mr.  
McKeown and the manager of the  
Royal Trust Company that the for-  
mer bonds and the mortgage they re-  
presented had been cancelled.

Mr. McKeown followed and read to  
the committee the certificate of the  
notary, Mr. F. R. Taylor, who was ap-  
pointed by all the parties to see to  
the cancellation of the \$150,000 in  
bonds held by the Eastern Trust Co.  
Mr. McKeown also explained that  
while it was impossible that this docu-  
ment should be on file in the provin-  
cial secretary's office, the really im-  
portant part of the transaction was  
on record in the Counties of Victoria  
and Madawaska where the old mort-  
gage was cancelled and the new one  
recorded.

This closed the incident except that  
the committee passed a vote of thanks  
to Messrs. Robinson and McKeown for  
their attendance and explanation, af-  
terwards passing the item over which  
the discussion arose.

summer in connection with the tercen-  
tary celebration has been consid-  
erably curtailed. Instead of thirty  
thousand uniformed men being as-  
sembled the number will probably be  
about five thousand. The reduction  
is due entirely to the problem of  
transportation.

The militia will hold camp at local  
headquarters.
