CARDINAL MANNING ON CHRISTIAN EDUCATION.  
The Cardinal-Archbishop of Westminster, preaching at St. Mary's, Horseferry-road, a few Sundays ago, from the words—"All power is given unto Me in Heaven and on earth. Go ye, therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost, teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you, and behold I am with you all days even to the consummation of the world," said:
