WHEREAS:-The 1910 Amendmen the Municipal Act, Sections 11, 12, 3, provides as follows:— (1) All tenements of a lesser rent-

ed value than \$50.00 shall be maintained by the owner or lessee in all respects reasonably fit for habitation. (2) The Council to have power to order any house not fit for habitation to be removed as

a nuisance. (3) The Council to have power to make Rules and Regulations putting and keeping dwelling houses in wholeso and sanitary condition.

BE IT RESOLVED:-(1) A house reasonably fit for habitation shall have its roof, outer walls, windows and doors sound and watertight.
