

Check Reckless Motoring

As a part of its programme to re-educate the reckless motorist from the highway, the National Automobile Chamber of Commerce of the United States has published the text of a new law for the impounding of motor vehicles of offenders. This law has been drawn by constitutional lawyers with the aim of getting a measure which will be practical and will be in accord with legislative precedent.

Taking away property which has been misused has precedent in some of the early fishing laws and in a large number of Volstead Act cases. Detroit is impounding vehicles by taking away the license of the car. Another method is to affix a police seal on the car in the owner's garage or the vehicle can be impounded in a public garage at the owner's expense.

The measure, as outlined, provides for public sale of the car where the offender does not meet the fees and expenses approved by the court for the seizure and detention of the vehicle.

The automobile organization has established this proposed law, not with the thought that it is necessarily the best for any particular situation, but to serve as a guide for a practical measure for any community which may have this form of legislation in mind. Copies may be obtained from the National Automobile Chamber of Commerce, 356 Madison Avenue, New York City, without charge. There are various methods of punishing the reckless motorist. Fines, however, are not a great worry to the prosperous, and it is hard to get a jury to impose jail sentences. It is felt that the impounding method of depriving the owner of the use of his car for a given period is more severe than a fine, and that the justice of the measure will appeal to jurors.

Commenting upon the proposed law, the traffic planning and safety committee of the Chamber says:

"It is stated by some that such a procedure is confiscation, and would be unconstitutional. We do not agree with this viewpoint. It is present procedure in all parts of the country to take from a man that which he has used to the detriment of the public. Thus we find police authorities everywhere confiscating automobiles, weapons, gambling devices, illicit liquor and conveyances used for the transport of such liquors. We have seen property taken from raided saloons. We have seen homes and business establishments padlocked when they have been used for disorderly purposes. If all this is legal, we believe that our suggestion of impounding cars is legal.

The point might also be raised that the care of impounded cars involves a problem and that it might be difficult for police authorities to find adequate storage space, or to insure return of the cars to their owners in first-class condition. Our plan does not involve any municipal fund. We would do one of two things: Either tie up the car in the owner's garage with police seals attached, or impound it in a public garage at the owner's expense, also with police seals attached. At the end of the penalty period, the police department would remove the seals and permit the car to be used once more."

The automobile industry offers this as a concrete suggestion, and will support the enactment of such a law in every State of the United States. It is a very drastic measure, which is not likely to receive general acceptance, but the prevalence of accidents in the United States has made imperative the necessity for the protection of life and limb.—Morning Chronicle.

Streets in Mid-Air

Pedestrians will walk above the flying maze of traffic on "second-story pavements" in Chicago's densely-packed business section if the plan of Mr. John J. Sloan, president of the local improvement board, is adopted.

Mr. Sloan proposes to raise the pavements to the second story level, at a cost of about \$1,000,000. Two stairways at every street intersection would give access to the overhead pavements, which would be about 13½ ft. from the street level. Merchants could offset the expense through the added display which they would gain exhibits in second-story windows, Mr. Sloan claims.

The pavements would be constructed on the cantilever principle, would hang the street about 2 ft., and as much as there would be a space from 6 to 10ft. between the building fronts and the edges of the pavement, they would not, it is claimed, cut off light and air from the floors below.

Second level pavements would under second floors attractive for shopping and display purposes, and would be a distinct benefit to the district affected," says Mr. Sloan.

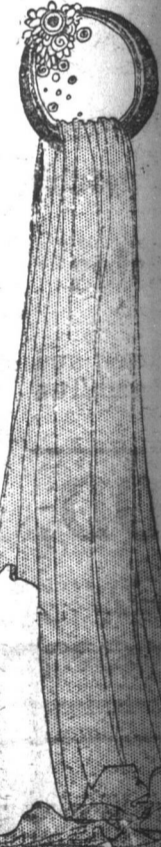
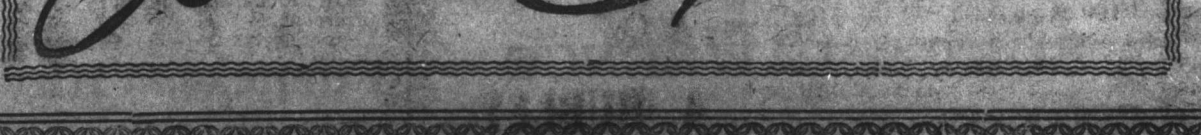
