Death of John Stuart Mill. On Friday, in Avignon, France, a great and original -pirit passed array—one whose life and thought have been the admiration of, the literary world, and whose memory and works will live when future gen-erations have swept into oblivion the social and political phenomena which agitate the leading minds of the day. John Stuart Mill was born in 1806, and was therefore 67 years of age when death called him away. He had received a private education, and in due course of time obtained a clerkship in the East India House. He gradually rose until, in 1856, he succeeded to the position his father had occupied before him, and re-thed from that service on the trans-fer of the administration from the Company to Her Maistr's Gavern

had occupied before him, and re-tired from that service on the trans-fer of the administration from the Company to Her Majesty's Govern-ment in 1858. Lord Starley offered him a seat in the Indian Council, but he declined the offer. Mr. Mil's mane is best known to the world as political economist, and as the author of A System of Logic," which was published in 1843. From 1835 to 1840 he was editor of the West-alaster herize, and during life was a contributor to the *Ediabacyl Review* and some of the monthly magazine. If the published 'Essays on Political Economy," "A Treatise on Liberty," and "An Examination of Sir W. Hamilton's Philosophy." In 1867 he was elected rector of St, Andrew's university, and his inaugural address stands out in striking contasts to most of those delivered from the same chair. He's served one term in Parliament as member for Weshnin-ster, but was defented at the last good service to the party with his ever ready pen. Had no other works been issued from he
