



the nerves, I tell you. About 40 miles from Arayat is San Meguil, the town we are now in. The General of the Filipiness who had the town fortified, sent word to General Lawton to bring on his forces, as he was ready for us, and bring them on he did. Our regiment came up from the south, the 4th Cavalry from the north, and A Battery of artillery from the east, and as it happened we were the ones who got the warm eception. We stumbled on their trenches about 4 o'clock in the morning of Dec. 12th, and until 12 o'clock we gave and received as fast as we could. We charged on the first line of trenches and took them, and were about to charge the second when they decamped to the mountains, and on Dec. 13th we walked into the town in sets of fours, with General Lawton at the head. last by the enemy, near Manilla. He entered a town that had a flag of truce up, and they fired on them and Lawton was killed, and his son, 12 years of age, was shot in the limb. Fourteen men were killed and one officer. We expect to take up our permanent quarters at a place called Bally Wog (that's how it sounds, I don't transfer to our regimental band, and will hereafter blow a piccalo instead of carrying foraging trip and brought in 21 ducks, 28
