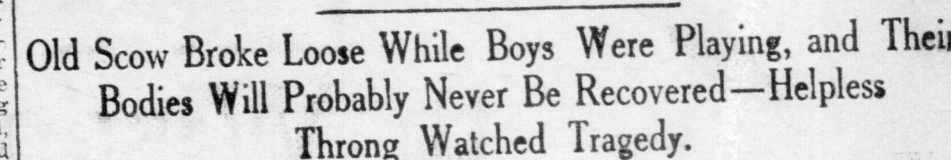


TWO LADS SWEEPED TO DEATH IN THE WHIRLPOOL RAPIDS



Niagara Falls, June 23.—On their knees in an old scow and clinging to the sides, two boys were this afternoon slowly carried through the lower river into the Whirlpool Rapids where they met death. Their bodies are in the water and may not be recovered.

The whirlpools, and the rocks were feared. Another boy, who was in the boat when it drifted out from the shore, jumped overboard and swam to safety.

The dead are Hubert, 9 years, son of Mrs. Emma Moore; a widow, and Mrs. Anna Moore, 14 years, son of William Roscoe, a miller, both of Niagara Falls, N. Y. The boy who swam ashore is Elliott, 14 years, son of Frank P. Roscoe, a miller, both of Niagara Falls, N. Y.

At the same time, the river was full of boats. The boatsmen were shouting, "Give us some help," were the words Roscoe was heard to utter after which his cries and those of the other boatsmen were drowned by the roar of the falls on one side and the rapids on the other.

For more than an hour the boat drifted helplessly in the basin above the Whirlpool Rapids. The children were seen to wave their hands to the boatsmen, and the crowd on the river bank was cheering and shouting.

At last, the boat was seen to drift down.

These boys with a number of others living in the neighborhood, which is adjacent to the river bank near the Gorge Railroad barns, have been in the habit of wandering down the cliffs to a shack built on the edge of the cliff. John Briggs, a recluse, who kept an old scow anchored to a stake by a chain. The three were playing in the boat this afternoon when a stick as big as a man's arm came down the chain would be drawn tight and the scow drift back to the shore. It

Rescuers Delayed. Seeing the danger, Thompson, the village sage of the tribe, jumped overboard to help the scow. But he was on one of the trips out of the chain gave way, and the craft was adrift in the river. The boys had nothing with which to paddle, and slowly the scow began to drift down stream.
