Norfolk Farmers See Veiled Threat in Tory Advertising

SIMCOE, Oct. 10.-A thinly-disguised attack by the National Liberal-Conservative supporters against J. Alex. Wallace, Farmer candidate for Norfolk, is seen in the call that went out today for a mass meeting to be held here next Monday to nominate a Government candidate. The exhortation reads: "A call to all persons, both men and women, who are in sympathy with the Meikign Government, irrespective of their former political leaning." That John H. Martin of Port Dover, known as the "warrior" because of his fighting a long and hard campaign for the asking is generally conceded, but whether he would accept it or not is a question that has not been answered. That protection vs. free trade will be the issue in this constituency is evident. The Liberal-Conservatives declare that the prime qualification of the candidate is that he "must be a protectionist."

65-Year-Old Deadline Has No Terror For These Stalwarts.

BRANTFORD, Oct. 10.-Postmaster W. G. Raymond, who resigned from office today, following his acceptance of the nomination as Liberal standard bearer in the riding of Brantford, is well past 65 years of age, but the postmaster 22 years here, but continued in office when the superannuation decree was lifted by the postmaster-general's department. Two other candidates, A. W. Burt, representing the organized Farmer-Labor element, and W. F. Cocksutt, Conservative, are also past the 65-year-old "deadline."
