**ZEPPELIN UNHURT
BY OCEAN VOYAGE**

ZR-3 Safely Housed in Air-
drome at Lakehurst, Fol-
lowing New Record.

Associated Press Despatch.
Airdrome, Lakehurst, N. J., Oct.
15.—The ZR-3 slumbered tonight
safely cradled in the Lakehurst air-
drome after a memorable flight
across the Atlantic Ocean.

Her German crew slumbered also
and her four American passengers.
The ship, which had set a new record
for sustained flight, appeared none
the worse for the effort.
As a further indication of the
strides lighter-than-air aeronautics
have taken during those five years,
the fuel tanks of the ZR-3 were one-
quarter full when she berthed. They
held 7½ tons—enough, according to
Lieut.-Commander S. M. Krauss, to
have carried her 1,800 knots far-
ther or a goodly part of the distance
to the Pacific coast.

**Platform Fall
Downs Premier**

London, Oct. 15.—Recalling a
similar mishap to Premier Mac-
kenzie King at Montreal a few
months ago, Premier Ramsay Mac-
Donald had an alarming experi-
ence, while addressing an audience
of 10,000 people at Cleckheaton
in Yorkshire, this afternoon. The
speakers' platform suddenly col-
lapsed, dropping the premier and
200 persons with him to the
ground. There was much excite-
ment, but no person was seriously
hurt. Mr. MacDonald picked him-
self up, mounted a point of van-
tage and smilingly continued his
address.

**TORONTO ASKS PERMIT
TO ENTER GAS BUSINESS**

able the city to distribute gasoline
to its citizens.

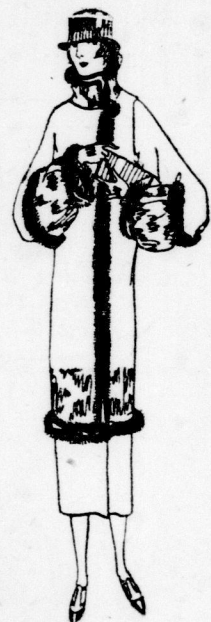

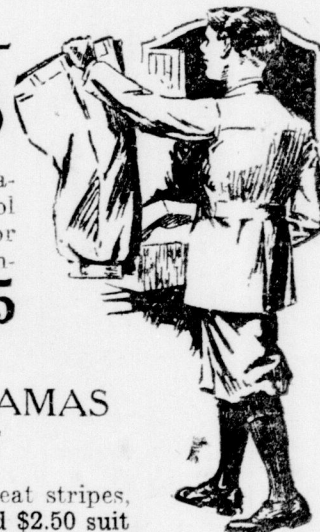

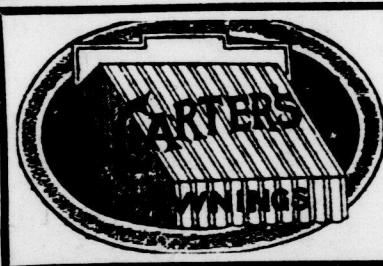
