THREE PERSONS PERISHED IN HOTEL FIRE

Half a Dozen Others Missing and Believed to Have Lost Their Lives

CINCINNATI, Ohio, April 25.—Three persons lost their lives and half a dozen others are believed to have perished in a fire which practically destroyed the Hotel Thomas shortly after midnight last night. Two of the dead have been identified as Walter G. Cameron, lawyer, and Harry Lawrence, proof reader on a morning paper. The third body has not been identified. The hotel was situated at Walnut and Sixth streets in the retail district. The flames are supposed to have been caused by crossed electric wires.

SIX FRENCH AVIATORS FLY OVER THE SEA

Six aeroplanists made successful flights over the sea from Nice to Cape Ferrat and return on Saturday, a total distance of about 15 miles. Hubert Latham, made the best time which was 16 minutes, 46 3-5 seconds. A seventh aeronaut, M. H. emondick, started, but fell with his machine into the water from which he was rescued uninjured by a torpedo boat.

WANTS TO ORGANIZE FRENCH-CANADIANS

Blondin, M. P. Would Form a New Party Modelled Along the Same Lines as the Nationalists

MONTREAL, Apr. 25.—Mr. Blondin, M. P. for Champlain, speaking at a meeting held at Orléans Landing today, advocated the formation of a French Canadian party from the province of Quebec, at Ottawa, on the same lines as the Irish party at Westminister. Mr. Blondin who declared himself as a supporter of Mr. Monk, on the naval policy, said that a French Canadian party would eventually hold the balance of power at Ottawa as the followers of John Redmond now hold the balance of power in the British common.

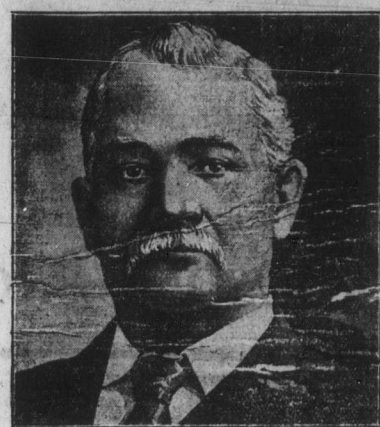
