In the course of a long report to the Public School Board on free text books, based upon personal investigation in Massachusetts, Inspector Hughes says: I have found the most unqualified approval of the system from teachers and officials. There are no chieffing as complaints. The law is a logical market. objections or complaints. The law is a logical outcome of the essential law giving the state the power to enforce compulsory atstate the power to enforce compulsory attendance, and it has given complete satisfaction, theoretically and practically. There is absolutely no difficulty in the experience of Massachusetts in regard to the spread of infectious diseases through the agency of the text books. There never has been any serious difficulty of such a character anywhere. The books are carefully handled and hist longer than was expected. Comparatively few books have ever been lost. The advantages of the free text book system may be stated briefly as follows: It is economical; the attendance more regular, and it is larger; pupils remain longer at school; the necessary supplies for efficient teaching can be obtained, and the teachers can therefore do much better work. This is especially true in the subjects of, drawing, especially true in the subjects of drawing, writing, bookkeeping, history, reading and literature. By the plan of circulating the books, the pupils in each school may read several histories, and literary works carefully selected, at a price less than that now paid for one history and one reading book. Again there is no delay in getting new books at the beginning of the term. The average time lost in this way is about a week each term; the free text books system entirely removes this difficulty. 


