

Hills running in mountain ranges to the N.W. Clay Slate with peaks of Summit from 12 to 13,000 feet high

Little Circle

Gravelly hills and marshy meadows

Course of the river changes Lake as a tributary to Cree River supposed to fall into Bathurst's Inlet

Summits of hills on both sides of the river are high and steep and are covered with birch and spruce

Rapids, canoe broke here Banks well wooded

A River enters here Lake of the Well wooded Red and blue Clay Slate

Rapids including beds of limestone

Cascade 40 feet perpendicular

Small streams running in various directions

FORT ENTERPRISE

Lake of the Shave Lake in the valley of the River on the slopes of the mountains

Water abundant except a few changes of rapid runs and lower rapids with abundance of various species of berries and bushes
