An Act respecting Agricultural Fertilizers.

CLTURAL FARTILIZERS came into force on the 1st of January, 1886 and that all Ferlizers sold thereafter require to be sold subject to the conditions and restrictions therein contained-the main features of which are as follows:

The expression "fertilizer" means and includes all fertilizers which are sold at more than TEN DOLLARS per ton, and which contains ammonia, or its equivalent of nitrogen, or phosphoric acid.

the month of January in each year, and before offering the same fertilizer for sale, transmit to the Minister of Inland Reverue, carriage paid, a scaled glass jar, containing at least two pounds of the fertilizer manufactured or imported manufactured or imported by him; and such sample shall be preserved by the Minister of Inland Revenue for the purpose of comparison with any sample of fertilizer which is obtained in the course of the twelve months then next ensure from such manufacturer or importer, and which is transmitted to the chief analyst for analysis.

If the fertilizer is put up in packages, every such package intended for sale or distribution within Canada shall have the manufacturer's certificate of analysis placed upon or securely attached to each package by the manufacturer; if the tertilizer is in bags it shall be distinctly stamped or printed upon each bag; if it is in barrels, it shall be either branded, stamped or printed upon the head of each barrel or distinctly printed upon good paper and securely pasted upon the head of each barrel, or upon a tag secure-ly attached to the head of each barrel; if it is in bulk, the manufacturer's certicate shall be produced and a copy given to each purchaser.

Every person who sells or offers or exposes for sale any fertilizer, in respect of which the provisions of this Act have not been complied with-or who permits a certificate of analysis to be attached to any package, bag or barrel of such ferti-lizer, or to be produced to the inspector, to accompany the bill of inspection of Every manufacturer or importer of such inspector, stating that the fertilizer fertilizers for sale, shall, in the course of contains a larger percentage of the concontains a larger percentage of the con-stituents mentioned in sub-section No. 11 of the Act than is contained therein —or who se'ls, offers or exposes for sale any fertilizer purporting to have been impreted, and which does not centain the percentage of constituents mentionby him, with the certificate of analysis ed in the next preceding section—or who of the same, together with an allidavit, sells or offers or exposes for sale any fersetting forth that each jar contains a fair average sample of the fertilizer centage of constituents mentioned in the manufacturer's certificate accompanying the same, shall be liable in each case to a penalty not exceeding fifty dollars for the first offence, and for each subsequent offence to a penalty not exceeding one hundred dollars. Provided always that deficiency of one per centum of the ammonia or its equivalent of nitrogen, or of the phosphoric acid, claimed to be contained shall not be considered as evidence of fraudulent intent.

The Act passed in the forty-seventh year of Her Maj-sty's reign, chaptered thirty-seven and entitled, "An Act to prevent fraud in the manufacture and sale of agricultural fertilizers," is by this Act repealed, except in regard to any oc.ence committed against it or any prosecution or other act commenced and not concluded or completed, and any payment of money due in respect of any provision thereof.
