Household Hints.

COCOA NIBS—Put one quarter pound cocoa-nibs into a china-lined saucepan, add one pint of warm water, and boil for twenty minutes; pour off the liquor into a jug, add another pint of warm water to the nibs, boil for twenty minutes and pour that off; add another pint of water (three pints in all) and boil for twenty minutes, and mix this with the other liquor. It will be found to have a delicious aroma and the soft flavour of the nibs, without any bitterness, which is apt to be the case when cocoa nibs are stewed for several hours.

CHICKEN SALAD—Two chickens, one bunch celery, half a pint of vinegar, one egg; one tablespoonful salad oil, one of liquid mustard, one of salt, half a tablespoonful of sugar, one spoonful of red pepper; make a custard of the egg and vinegar, beat oil, mustard and red pepper together, stir into the custard, add celery just before using. This is enough for ten persons.

CHOPPED BEEF—When the patient is a little stronger and can digest solid food, take the very choicest part of the tenderloin and chop it very fine; make it into little cakes, like sausage meat, salting it to taste. Boil over a quick fire and serve warm.

RICE SOUP—To make about a quart of soup, take a part of white stock and to it put a bay leaf, a small piece of onion, a stalk of celery and a large tablespoonful and a half of rice. Let it cook slowly for an hour; then add a teaspoonful of butter, a pint of cream, and pepper and salt to taste. Stir well; let it just boil, and it is ready to serve.

LEMON PIE—Roll three lemons till soft. Take out the seeds and juice and chop the peel very fine. To the juice and peel add two cups of molasses and two rolled crackers. Stir it well, adding one cup of water. This will make four pies.

POUND CAKE—Yelks of ten eggs and whites of two well beaten, one pound butter, one pound sugar, one pound flour, two teaspoonful Cleveland's Superior Baking Powder, one cup milk. Add flour and beaten whites last.

HASH—Take four cupsful of meat, free from gristle and fat, and chop it fine. Brown a teaspoonful of flour and mix with the meat, add a third of a cupful of gravy and three tablespoonful warm water, and let it cook slowly for ten minutes, giving it an occasional stir. Let it set for a few moments on the back of the stove where it will cool a little, add half a cupful of cream, heat thoroughly, pour over thin slices of toasted bread, and serve.

BAKED BANANAS—Cut a strip from one side of the bananas, and place them in a pan with this side uppermost. Sprinkle with granulated sugar and bake in a moderate oven until they are soft and tender, watching carefully that they do not burn. Serve very hot.
