

COCOA NIBS - Put one quarter pound cocoa-nibs into a china-lined saucepan, add one pint of warm water and boil for twenty minutes; pour ell the liquor into a jug, add another pint; of warm water to the nibs, boil for twenty minutes and pour that off; add another pint of water (three pints in all) and boil for twenty minutes, and mix this with the other liquor. It will be found to have a delicious aroma and the soft flavour of the nibs, without any bitterness, which is apt to be the case when cocoa nibs are stewed for several hours.

CHICKEN SALAD, -Two chickens, one bunch celery, half a pint of vine gar, one agg; one tablespoonful salad oil, one of liquid mustard, one of salt, half a tablespoonful of sugar, one salt-spoonful of red pepper; make a cus-tard of the egg and vinegar, beat oil. mustard and red pepper together, stir into the custard, add celesy just before using.
