2 Chron. 34. 1-13 [Commit to memory verses 1-3]

1 Jo-si'ah was eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned in Je-ru'sa-lem one and thirty years.

2 And he did that which was right in the 2 And he due that wenter was right in the sight of the Lord, and walked in the ways of Da'vid his father, and declined neither to the right hand, nor to the left.

6 And so did he in the cities of Ma-nas'seh, and E'phra-im, and Sim'e-on, even unto Naph'ta-li, with their mattocks round about.

And when he had broken down the altars and the groves, and had beaten the graven images into powder, and cut down all the idols throughout all the land of Is'ra-el, he returned to Je-ru'sa-lem.
